

Bringing literature to life.

Make your own origami bird!

You can use a square piece of paper to make your very own beautiful origami bird - it's easy! Just follow the simple steps below to bring your bird to life. You could even add some colour to it to really make it your own!



Step 1

Place your paper like a diamond with one corner pointing up.



Step 2

Fold the paper in half by folding the top corner to the bottom corner. You should have an upside down triangle.



Step 3

Fold part of the top down so that the edge is about halfway down. Don't make this flap too thin because this will become the wings.



Step 4

Turn the paper over.



Step 5

Take the bottom corner of the top layer and fold it up like this.



Step 6

Fold the figure in half by folding the left side over to the right.



Step 7

Now fold that same flap back like this to make one of the wings.



Step 8

Fold the other wing back also.



Step 9

Push the centre of the head in and flatten.



Ta-da!

You have yourself a bird!
